Land Use	The project would replace commercial use, some of which is vacant, with 100 new homes and 10,000 square-feet of ground-floor retail. There will be no car parking.	5
Density	The project successfully uses a challenging, space-constrained site and provides 100 smaller units with plenty of common open space.	5
Affordability	The project will include the BMRs onsite, totaling 12 homes affordable to residents earning up to 55 percent of the Area Median Income. The project sponsor is exploring the Inclusionary “dial.”	4
Parking and Alternative Transportation	The site is located in a transit-rich location and is within walking distance to neighborhood amenities and job centers. The project will be car free and include 160 bicycle parking spaces.	5
Preservation	There are no structures of significant cultural or historic merit on or near the site that would be impacted by the proposed project.	N/A
Urban Design	We commend the project sponsor for overcoming the challenges of this space-constrained site and including generous, open ground-floor retail that activates the streetscape.	5
Environmental Features	The building intends to achieve LEED Silver. We encourage the project sponsor to explore more features that will further green the building, especially water conservation.	3
Community Input	The project sponsor has met with HVNA, adjacent property owners and City supervisors. We encourage your team to engage with our trade union members.	4
Additional Comments	There are no other comments to add.	
Final Comments	The SF Housing Action Coalition endorses the proposed project at 1740 Market Street without reservation.	4.4/5
